

## GENERAL SITE SAFETY

- Obey All site notices and regulations
- Be aware of moving plant or vehicles
- Report unsafe defects in plant or equipment Immediately
- Ensure ladders are footed or tied
- Use only the correct tools or equipment for the job.
- Ensure tools are kept in good condition
- Do not interfere with any electrical equipment
- Do not enter any building, manhole, or site excavation unless authorised to do so by the site management
- Do not move or alter any site scaffold
- Do not drive plant unless you have the specific plant ticket and are authorised by the site management to do so
- Do not ride on, interfere with, or climb on plant if you are not the designated driver

## Health & Welfare

- ◆ Food and drink must not be consumed on site, except in designated areas



- ◆ Before eating or drinking ensure you wash your hands with soap and water

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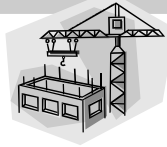

## Site Induction



**Your site induction is important**  
**You must pay attention to what the Management tell you.**

## Personal Protective Equipment—PPE

1. Hard hats, safety foot-wear and high visibility clothing **must** be worn at all times on site.
2. Any other protective equipment must also be worn as required or as instructed by the management.
3. All protective equipment must be maintained in good condition.



## First Aid & Accident Reporting

1. Any minor or major injuries must be reported straight away to the site manager or the appointed first aider. Be sure you know where these people are situated. (as per your site induction)



2. It is your responsibility to ensure the incident/accident is recorded in the accident book.
3. All accidents, near miss accidents or dangerous occurrences must be reported to the site management.
4. All incidents that result in an absence from work must be reported to the site manager and to One Way Resourcing representative



## On Site Fire Precautions

1. Follow the procedures set out by the contractor.



## Manual Handling



1. Employees should identify to their manager any situation that gives rise to them not being able to carry out the manual handling task in a comfortable manner. **Seek assistance!**
2. All activities have risks, methods should be communicated to you by the site management.

## Drugs & Alcohol

1. No person will be employed who is under the influence of alcohol. If any person reports for work and is found to be in such a condition he/she will be sent home.
2. The use of non-prescription drugs is not acceptable and anyone appearing to be under the influence of such substances will be sent home.
